Your Centre has chosen to participate in the Relaython this season.

The Relaython was reintroduced this season to mark our 40th Anniversary of donating to the Royal Children's Hospital Good Friday Appeal. To date our organisation has donated almost \$750,000-00. An accomplishment we are very proud of.

This event is usually conducted on a 400 metre circular lap around your track where athletes run a designated distance with a baton which is passed onto another athlete. There can be no stopping of the athlete or the baton moving for the duration of the Relaython.

There are no restrictions on the number of times an athlete may run.

Centres will phone in their results each hour in a competition against other Centres to see who will run the most laps and raise the most money.

Athletes and their families are asked to obtain sponsors for this event with the form attached to this letter.

The prizes for season 2011/2012 are:

- The Centre which raises the most money
- The Centre which raises the most money per capita
- The Centre with the greatest distance
- The Centre with the greatest distance per capita
- The athlete who raises the most money
